a	Assess the exemption is not for any dangerous goods indicated as forbidden under any circumstance		
b	Assess the exemption reason is essential and justified. The decision to grant an exemption should not be based on cost alone		
c	Assess the applicable regulatory provisions to includes the identification of specific provisions that will not be met, thus requiring a determination that an equivalent level of safety has been achieved		
d	Assess any potential increased risk to safety or property that may result from deviating from the provisions in question and identification of the measures considered necessary or appropriate to address that risk. This should include substantiation with applicable analysis or an evaluation demonstrating that the proposed additional measures will achieve a level of safety that is at least equal to that required by the Technical Instructions		
e	Assess risk assessment to identify and evaluate potential risks in transport. This may include a risk analysis addressing failure modes and effects, a systems safety evaluation, and an explanation of the measures imposed to ensure each risk factor has been evaluated, in order to provide an appropriate level of safety		
f	Assess the packaging to be used provide a level of safety at least equivalent to that which is needed in order to meet the applicable requirements of Parts 4 and 6 of the Technical Instructions		
g	Assess the proposed safety control measures that will achieve a level of safety to that provided by the ICAO TI is satisfactory		
h	Where an exemption or approval is required from more than one State, assess that applicant has obtain the exemption from the states concerned, state concerned are the state of origin, operator, transit, over flight and destination
