Procedures of Issuing Overflying Permit for flights Carrying Dangerous Materials.

Flights Carrying Dangerous Materials:- :- Any flights carrying materials classified as dangerous according to Article (34) of the Civil Aviation Law and the followed instructions and procedures in this regard.

Documents and Information to be Submitted by the Applicant:

1. Overflying Permit application ([Form 10-2010](#)) through [a supervision agent](#) or the company representative office. Application shall include :

- A. Operator name .
- B. Nationality and Registration marks of the Aircraft.
- C. Type of Aircraft .
- D. Aircraft call sign .
- E. Date and time of the flight .
- F. Flight Route.
- G. Purpose of the flight.
- H. The nature of the dangerous material according to the specified number (UN Number) of the United Nations lists regarding such materials .
- I. Airway bill .
- J. Address of the applicant

- Sequence and Details of the Work Stages :

1. The applicant shall submit overflying permit application for flights carrying dangerous materials through [a supervision agent](#) or a representative office before (72) hours for the first time and then for(24)hours of the flight by E-Mail airclearances@carc.gov.jo or Fax No .00/962/6/4874756 or through *(AFTN) system .
2. In case of approval , the permit shall be issued and the applicant shall be informed the number of the permit .
3. In case the application is not approved , the applicant shall be informed and the reasons shall be mentioned.

Needed Time to Issue overflying Permit for Flights Carrying Dangerous Materials:

(72)hours for the first time and then (24) hours is the time needed to issue over flight permit for flights carrying dangerous materials after receiving all requirements .
