Annex 1 to Advisory Circular: AC-35-COVID19-01 dated April 2020

1. Introduction:

In order to facilitate safe operations during these difficult times and in line with the ICAO State Letter AN 11/55-20/50 of 3 April 2020 titled "Operational measures to ensure safe operations during the COVID-19 pandemic Operational measures for safe operations", Jordanian Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission (JCARC) is providing for the necessary flexibility by promulgating temporary alleviation operational measures while adhering to its obligations under the Convention of the International Civil Aviation (Chicago Convention, Doc 7300).

Taking into consideration the graduated steps achieved to restore the operational capacity of the civil aviation sector including the ease of lockdown restrictions, reopening the governmental sector in Jordan including the services provided by JCARC and reopening of Approved Training Organizations including Aviation Academies and Domestic Flight Simulators.

All above mentioned leading to narrow down the eligibility of exemption granting legislative tool in accordance to the article (12/b) of the Civil Aviation Law No.41 2007 as amended and JCAR Part 11.

2. Status:

This Annex 1 is an amending annex to the AC-35-COVID19-01 and will be effective on 31 July 2020 until March 31, 2021 unless being withdrawn by CARC.

3. Withdrawn Paragraphs:

All paragraphs under AC-35-COVID19-01are considered withdrawn with exceptions for the cases mentioned in this Annex.

4. Exceptions:

4.1. Already granted exemptions based on the AC-35-COVID19-01 with still standing requirements which cannot be achieved under the current business resumption status are eligible to be extended for 3 months until March 31, 2021 and under the same conditions mentioned in the AC-35-COVID19-01.

4.2. New applications with requirements cannot be achieved due to the COVID19 pandemic related national and/or international procedures and/or consequences are eligible to go through the exemption granting legislative tool in accordance to the Article (12/b) of the Civil Aviation Law No.41 2007 as amended and JCAR Part 11 until March 31, 2021 with reference to JCARC Commissioners' Council Decision No. 19 of year 2020.

5. Normal Applications:

All other applications are subjected to "back to normal" processes and procedures before the issuance of AC-35-COVID19-01.
