

## **Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission**

Procedures for Issuing a permit for overflying or Landing for Emergency, Search, Rescue, and Ambulance flights

**Emergency flight**: It is a flight where it is necessary to change the flight route or change the landing place suddenly due to abnormal conditions such as climate change in the air or technical malfunction in the plane or because of unusual circumstance on board.

**Search and rescue flight:** It is a flight that aims to search and rescue in exceptional cases.

**Ambulance flight**: It is a flight to carry patients and injured.

## Required Documents and information from the applicant:

- 1.Permit application :-shall include the following :-
  - A. Operator name.
  - B. nationality and Registration marks of the aircraft.
  - C. Type of aircraft.
  - D. Aircraft call sign.
  - E. Date and time of the flight.
  - F. Flight route.
  - G. Address of the Applicant.

## - Sequence and Details of the Work stages:

- 1. The application of permit shall be submitted by E-Mil airclearances@carc.gov.jo or fax No.00/962/6/4274756 or telephone No.(00/962/79751158) or through ministry of foreign Affairs, or by direct contact with the radar.
- 2. The permit shall be immediately issued when submitting the application.
