We, Abdullah II Ibn Al-Hussein, King of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, pursuant to Article (31) of the Constitution, and based on the Council of Ministers' resolutions dated 23/12/2019, ordain to enact the following bylaw:

BYLAW NO. (7) OF 2020 ADVANCED PASSENGER INFORMATION

ISSUED PURSUANT TO ARTICLES (67) AND (70) OF CIVIL AVIATION LAW NO. 41 OF 2007

Article (1)

This bylaw shall be cited (ADVANCED PASSENGER INFORMATION) FOR **2020** and shall come into effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

Article (2)

The following words and expressions wherever mentioned in this bylaw shall have the meanings assigned to them below, unless the context indicates otherwise: -

Commission: Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission ("CARC")

Directorate: General Intelligence Directorate ("GID")

Passenger: The traveler on international flights who has a confirmed ticket, including the traveler arriving to or departing from the Kingdom, the Transfer Passenger or the Transit Passenger.

Transfer Passenger: The traveler arriving to the Kingdom for the purpose of traveling to an international destination, departing on another plane within less than 24 hours.

Transit Passenger: The traveler arriving to the Kingdom for the purpose of traveling to an international destination without leaving the plane.

Service Provider: The contracting party implementing the Advanced Passenger Information System in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.

Advance Passenger Information System: is an electronic System which includes:

- A. Advance Passenger Information (API)
- B. Interactive Advanced Passenger Information (IAPI)
- C. Passenger Name Record (PNR)
- D. Information of Departure Control System and Boarding Pass Issuance (DCS INFO)
- E. Boarding Pass

Article (3)

The Directorate undertakes the management, implementation and operation of the Advanced Passenger Information System, and for this purpose, it shall have the right to contract with the Service Provider and perform all legal actions necessary to implement the provisions of this Bylaw.

Article (4)

The CARC cooperate with the GID to ensure the implementation of the Advance Passenger Information System, and for this purpose it shall:

- A. Officially issue monthly and semiannual reports on the Passenger numbers, and when requested to do so.
- B. Following up on all correspondences, communications and transactions with airlines.

Article (5)

- A. The application and implementation of the Advanced Passenger Information System shall be part of the National Facilitation Program.
- B. Airlines shall be under obligation to provide the Service Provider with the information required for implementing and applying the Advanced Passenger Information System in accordance with the National Facilitation Program.

Article (6)

A. A fee for applying, implementing and operating the Advanced Passenger Information System and its supporting services shall be levied on Passengers in accordance with the following:

- 1- (1.750 JOD) one dinar and 750 fils for each Passenger arriving to or departing from the Kingdom.
- 2- (1.250 JOD) one dinar and 250 fils for each Transfer or Transit Passenger.
- B. The fee set out in Paragraph (A) of this Article is imposed on the Transfer Passenger upon arriving to and departing from the Kingdom.
- C. Aircraft crews, extra crews, and children of two (2) years age and less are exempted from the fee set out in Paragraph (A) of this Article.

Article (7)

The fees payments, resulting from the application of this Bylaw, that are not paid in due time shall be subject to an annual legal interest of nine (9%) percent imposed prorate on the delay periods as per the instructions issued for this purpose.

Article (8)

A. The fess set out in Article 6 of this Bylaw shall be collected from the tickets issued after the effective date of this Bylaw by carriers or the issuing airlines through the ticket or Passenger list (the manifest) as the case may be..

B. The airlines shall:

- 1. Pay directly the Service Provider the fees within the month following the month in which the fees were imposed.
- 2. Pay CARC the accrued interest from late payments of fees in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph B of this Article.

Article (9)

The Passengers' information, data and documents are protected in accordance with the provisions of this Bylaw and shall be subject to the provisions of the legislations in force.

Article (10)

Any breach to the provisions of this Bylaw shall be subject to the penalties stipulated in the Civil Aviation Law and the instructions issued pursuant thereto.

Article (11)

The Board of Commissioners of the CARC shall, upon the recommendation of its Chief Commissioner, issue the instructions necessary to implement the provisions of this Bylaw.
