Flight Examiners Privileges Guide

- 1. Type Rating Examiner (TRE). Airplane & Flight Synthetic Training Devices (FSTD)
 - (a) Skill tests for the issue of type ratings for multi-pilot airplanes
 - (b) Proficiency checks for revalidation or renewal of multi-pilot type and instrument ratings
 - (c) Operator proficiency checks
 - (d) Skill tests for ATPL(A) issue

2. Synthetic Flight Examiner (SFE). FSTD only

- (a) Skill tests for the issue of type ratings for multi-pilot airplanes provided he holds a valid type rating on the applicable airplane type
- (b) Proficiency checks for revalidation or renewal of multi-pilot type and instrument ratings
- (c) Operator proficiency checks
- (d) (c) Skill test for ATPL (A) issue.
- (e) Skill tests for MPL issue, provided that the examiner has complied with the requirement JCAR-FCL1.310(d).
- (f) Assessment of competence for the issue, revalidation or renewal of an SFI certificate in the relevant aircraft category, provided that the examiner has completed at least 3 years as an SFE.

3. Class Rating Examiner (CRE).

- (a) Skill tests for the issue of class and type ratings for single-pilot airplanes.
- (b) Proficiency checks for revalidation or renewal of class and type ratings for single pilot airplanes
- (c) Proficiency checks for revalidation of instrument ratings for single pilot airplanes

4. Flight Examiner PPL Level (FE-PPL level).

- (a) Skill tests for the issue of the PPL(A), and
- (b) Skill tests and proficiency checks for the associated single-pilot class/type rating

- 5. Flight Examiner CPL Level (FE-CPL level).
 - (a) Skill tests for the issue of a CPL (A), and
 - (b) Skill test and Proficiency checks for the associated single-pilot class/type ratings
- 6. **Flight Instructor Examiner (FIE).** Skill tests and proficiency checks or renewals for the issue and revalidation of flight instructor ratings
- 7. Instrument Rating Examiner (IRE).
 - (a) Skill tests for the initial issue of instrument ratings, and
 - (b) Proficiency checks for the revalidation or renewal of instrument ratings
